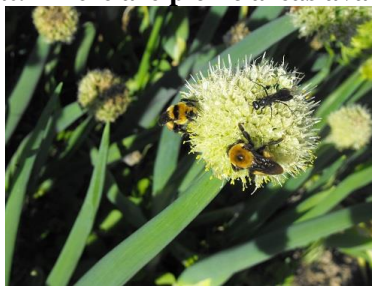
9th Annual SEED FESTIVAL Sept. 5th
